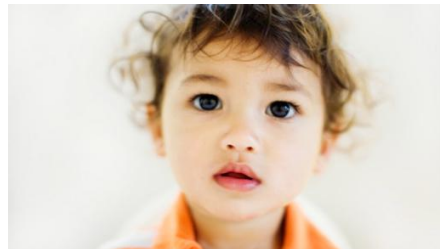




Very Early Intervention
