Using functional neuroimaging to study brain development and autism

Young volunteers with an autism spectrum disorder (**ASD**) are needed to participate in research studies investigating brain function during problem solving and face recognition tasks. Volunteers will participate in neuropsychological and neuroimaging testing.

We need volunteers who:

- are 7-25 years old
- have a diagnosis of an autism spectrum disorder

We would like to obtain functional brain images and measure volunteers' magnetic brainwaves while they are working out problem solving tasks and looking at pictures of faces. This is completely non-invasive and does not involve any form of radiation.

Participants will receive pictures of their brain, a small gift, and volunteer hours!
